Big Bikes and Minis Only - No quads or pit bikes  
All mini races Hare Scramble Format  
Big Bikes Qualifier Format Only-No Time Keeping  
Approx mileage AA/A/B - 65 miles, C's - 50 miles  
Transponders required! Must check into registration prior to racing  
Late arrivals will not be allowed to race  
Four riders per minute at start transfer  
Riders will start test sections every 15 seconds  
Gas Pit/ Rider Support at Fay Canyon Trail Head- gas trailers provided  
AMRA numbers and backgrounds not required  
You will be assigned a race/row number for this race only  
No jetting loop-come prepared- elevation 6500-7300'

Staging/Registration/camping - located on Forest Rd 700 and 236 off of the Kelly Canyon Exit I-17 North- Ward Camp 35.029157-111.658282  
Camping is limited along Forest Road FR 236, dispersed camping on APPROVED forest service lands only.

NO CAMPING IN OPEN MEADOWS-THEY ARE CLOSED TO ALL VEHICLES- STAY UNDER THE TREES Fires in approved containers only!  
No fire rings please! Extinguish all fires please! Please pack out all garbage, PACK IT IN- PACK IT OUT! Please keep motorcycles on roads or trails NO OPEN RIDING ON FORESET SERVICE LAND  
STAY OUT OF WARD MEADOW PLEASE!!

DO NOT RACE TRANSFER SECTIONS- enjoy them!

All Forest Road 700 transfers 20 mph MAX

There are many road crossings - to many to man-be vigilant in looking both ways before crossing! Road crossings in TEST SECTIONS will be marked with double-down arrows. Safety First - it will be a busy holiday weekend in the Coconino National Forest - Be Aware!!

#### Technical Inspection

96 db sound test -strictly enforced- be prepared to repack if necessary  
USFS approved spark arrestor- strictly enforced  
Kill switch, DOT approved helmet, Goggles- NO TEAR OFFS  
Gloves & boots, Hydration system  
Suggested: Hand guards, chest protection, knee/shin/elbow guards  
Skid plate/rotor guards, Tool kit/spare parts, Rain jacket
